TOWN OF KENLY, NORTH CAROLINA, RESOLUTION TO ADOPT ANNUAL BALANCED BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023-2024 202305-03

WHEREAS, the Town of Kenly is required by the North Carolina Local Government Budget and Fiscal Act to adopt an annual balanced budget; and

WHEREAS, a balanced budget has been prepared for the Town of Kenly for fiscal year 2023-2024 under the provisions set forth in the above-referenced legislation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Council of the Town of Kenly adopts the following budget ordinance:

BUDGET ORDINANCE: 202405-03 FISCAL YEAR (FY) 2024-2025

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS AND THE RAISING OF REVENUE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2024

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Town Council of the Town of Kenly, North Carolina, that the following anticipated fund revenues and departmental expenditures, together with certain Fee and Charge Schedules and with certain restrictions and authorizations, are hereby appropriated and approved for the operation of the Town Government and its activities for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2024, and ending June 30, 2025.

SECTION 4.A. LEVY OF TAXES

There is hereby levied a tax at the rate of sixty-three cents (\$0.69) per one hundred dollars (\$100) valuation of property as listed for taxes as of January 1, 2025, for the pm-pose of current year property taxes listed under "Ad Valorem Taxes" in the General Fund in Section 2A. This rate is based on an estimated total valuation of property for the purposes of taxation of \$165,755,573 and an estimated rate of collection of ninety-eight and seven tenths percent (99.0%).

SECTION 4.B. MUNICIPAL VEHICLE TAX

Pursuant to NCGS 20-97 there is hereby levied a tax of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) per motor vehicle residing in the Town of Kenly, for the purpose of current year taxes listed under "Motor Vehicle Tax" in the General Fund in Section 2A. This rate is based on an estimated one thousand one hundred eighty-six (1,186) vehicles.

SECTION 5. SPECIAL AUTHORIZATION - BUDGET OFFICER

- A. The Town Manager is authorized to transfer amounts up to \$25,000 between departments, including contingency appropriations, with the same fund. He/she must make an official report on such transfers at the next regular meeting of the Town Council.
- B. The Town Manager may transfer amounts between line-item expenditures within a department without limitation and without a report being required. These changes should not result in increases in recurring obligations such as salaries
- C. The Town Manager may not transfer any amounts between funds, except as approved by the Town Council in the Budget Ordinance as amended.
- D. Town Manager is hereby designated Finance Officer and is authorized to make interfund loans for a period of not more than **120 days.** The Finance Officer shall establish and maintain accounting procedures which follow the statutes of the State

of North Carolina. Interfund transfers, established in the budget document, may be accomplished without recourse to the council.

E. The Town Manager shall have the authority to obligate through necessary agreements, contracts, or other such documents funds included in this budget ordinance and may execute contracts up to \$35,000 in accordance with Article 8 of Chapter 143 of North Carolina General Statutes and the Town of Kenly's Purchasing Policy, as may be enacted or amended from time to time.

SECTION 6. UTILIZATION OF BUDGET ORDINANCE

This ordinance shall be the basis of the financial plan for the Town of Kenly municipal government during the 2024-2025 Fiscal year. The Town Manager shall administer the budget, and he/she shall ensure that operating officials are provided guidance and sufficient details to implement their appropriate portion of the budget.

The Administration Department shall establish and maintain all records, which are in consonance with this Budget Ordinance, and the appropriate Statutes of the State of North Carolina.

SECTION 7.A. RE-APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS ENCUMBERED IN FY 2023-2024

Appropriations herein above authorized and made shall have amounts of the unearned portion of contracts at June 30, 2025, added to each appropriation as it applied in order to properly account for payment against the fiscal year for which it is paid.

SECTION 7.B. PROJECT BUDGET ORDINANCES

All Project Budget Ordinance appropriations are continued.

SECTION 8. Copies of this ordinance and the attached budget and any relevant fee schedules shall be maintained in the office of the Town Clerk of the Town of Kenly and shall be made available for public inspection.
